Uniform Policy

1. Introduction

At **Sheen Mount Primary School**, we believe a consistent school uniform contributes to a sense of belonging, equality, and pride. This Uniform Policy outlines expectations for all pupils across our three forms in each year group. The policy supports our values of respect, responsibility, and readiness to learn.

This policy applies to all pupils and should be read alongside our Behaviour and Attendance policies.

2. Aims of the Uniform Policy

Our uniform aims to:

- Promote a sense of identity and unity.
- Ensure pupils dress in a safe, practical, and appropriate way.
- Reduce peer pressure related to clothing.
- Present a positive image of the school in the community.
- Offer options that are affordable and accessible.

3. General Expectations

- All pupils must wear the correct uniform every school day unless otherwise advised by the school.

- Clothing should be clean, well-fitting, and in good condition.
- All items should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name.
- Parents/carers are responsible for ensuring children arrive in the correct uniform.

The only items that have the Sheen Mount emblem on are:

- The polo shirt
- The jumper/cardigan
- The PE t-shirt
- The hoodie for PE days

All other items can be bought from any shop.

There is no requirement to have the Sheen Mount emblem on items.

4. School Uniform Requirements

4.1 Main School Uniform

Winter:

- dark long grey trousers or grey shorts
- plain grey pinafore dress, skirt or culottes
- plain white blouse, shirt or polo shirt or school motif polo shirt
- plain dark green jumper or cardigan, or school sweatshirt/cardigan
- plain and unbranded grey or black socks with trousers/shorts or dark green, grey or black socks/tights with skirts or culottes (no striped sports socks)

Summer:

- green and white striped or checked dresses for girls
- plain and unbranded grey, black or white socks with trousers/shorts or white, dark green, grey or black socks/tights with dresses/skirts or culottes (no striped sports socks)

Shoes:

- Strong, lace-up, velcro or buckled shoes in black (plain black trainers may also be worn but no other colours to be visible)

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly named!

4.2 PE Kit

- black PE shorts or skorts
- colour team t-shirts can be purchased here: <https://sheensports.com/product/sheen-mount-performance-tee/>
- (NOTE: all Reception children who join at the beginning of the September term will be given their first colour team t-shirt, thanks to the generosity of the PSA)
- sensible sports trainers
- drawstring shoe bag for PE clothes (no large rucksacks please)
- in winter, pupils may wear plain, dark-coloured tracksuit bottoms (during the colder weather) and a Sheen Mount (or other) dark-coloured hoodie

Please note the green hoodie worn for PE cannot be worn on non PE days.

4.3 Swimming Kit

A draw-string bag, complete with:

- a sports swimming costume (no baggy swimming trunks or bikinis)
- a swimming hat
- goggles
- a towel

4.4. General Guidance

- plain waterproof coat, jacket or Sheen Mount fleece (for outside wear only). Umbrellas should be for drop off and pick up only
- for Reception and KS1, Sheen Mount book bags are available to purchase via Arbor. Please send an email to the school office to let them know, and it will be delivered to your child at school. Pupils in KS2 should bring a sturdy backpack of their choosing
- jewellery, except watches and stud earrings, must not be worn (jewellery worn for a religious reason must be approved by the Headteacher/smart watches with connectivity are not allowed)
- nail varnish is not allowed
- for both boys and girls, hair that reaches the shoulder must be tied back

5. Jewellery, Hair, and Accessories

5.1 Jewellery

- One pair of small, plain stud earrings allowed
- No hoop earrings, necklaces, bracelets, or rings
- Watches permitted (Fitbits but no smartwatches with calls/messages)

5.2 Hair

- Natural hair colours only
- For both boys and girls, hair that reaches the shoulder must be tied back for safety
- No extreme styles (e.g., shaved designs, mohawks)

5.3 Accessories

- Hairbands and clips must be small
- No makeup or nail varnish

6. Lost Property

- The school maintains a lost-property system for mislaid items.
- Unnamed items may be donated or recycled at the end of each term.

7. Uniform Suppliers

Uniform items can be sourced from:

- www.stitchdesign.co.uk for items named above in section 3. All other items can be purchased from any shop.

8. Support and Financial Assistance

Families experiencing financial difficulty can contact the school office/class teacher/leadership team for help with:

- Pre-loved uniform.

The PSA have monthly pre-loved uniform sales out of the permanent shop/shed in the Orchard playground and the school actively supports this.

9. Exceptions and Reasonable Adjustments

We will accommodate:

- Religious dress requirements
- Cultural dress needs
- SEND or medical related adaptations

Parents/carers should contact the school to discuss adjustments.

10. Non-Compliance Procedures

If a pupil is not in correct uniform:

1. A gentle reminder will be given.
2. Parents/carers may be contacted.
3. Persistent non-compliance will follow the school's behaviour procedures.

Reasonable and respectful discretion will always be applied.

11. Review of Policy

This policy will be reviewed annually or sooner if statutory guidance changes.
